Works which have not been submitted via email will not be accepted into the show.

- There is a limit of **3 wall-hanging artworks** that may be submitted by each artist. If space does not permit, all works may not be able to be accepted.
- Due to space, you may submit one large piece, but only one of your artwork submissions can be more than 18 x 24" (not including the frame).
- No sculptures or jewelry will be accepted because there is no place in the venue to display them.
- Early submissions are helpful to us for the best chance of being used for show publicity.



- For our records and for creating the labels, please accurately provide the following information. Registration via email with subject line: Water Exhibit Submissions should include:
- 1. Title of Work
- 2. Artist
- 3. Medium
- 4. Sale price or NFS (Not for Sale) or POR (Price on Request)
- 5. Dimensions
- 6. Website URL (optional)
- 7. Preferred email address
- 8. Phone number (for GAL use ONLY)
- 9. JPEG photo of SUBMITTED piece at 300 ppi, 2100 pixels on the longest dimension

REQUIREMENTS:

- Submit family friendly works suitable for hanging in a public place.
- All styles from realism to abstract to conceptual are welcome.
- All artwork must depict or be inspired by the theme. Water should be presented in an unusual form, such as, water reflections, abstractions of water, frost on a window, ice crystals, ice carvings, snow, vapor, fog, steaming beverages, clouds, etc. The main focus of the art piece should be the presentation of water in an unusual form.
- All works must be **WIRED** and ready for hanging. No sawtooth will be accepted. If you have any questions, email GAL well in advance.
- GAL reserves the right to refuse any works that are unsafe, improperly framed or wired, still wet, or unsuitable for hanging in any other way.
- In the event that space does not permit, **not all works will be accepted**.
- Works must be delivered and retrieved on dates and times indicated. If you have any
 problems with the agreed upon times, contact GAL via email WELL in advance. If you
 cannot pick up your works as indicated, please make arrangements with a
 representative to do so. If a representative is dropping off your work, be certain they
 know that there is a sign-in procedure. Be sure they have ALL the necessary information
 in order to sign in for you properly.
- Only artworks will be accepted at the site. All protective wrappings and carrying devices must be removed by artist/representative and taken from premises.
- All works must remain until the end date of the show.
- Upon delivery of your work, you will be asked to indicate some sort of finger food or beverage you may like to contribute for the reception. Both savory and sweet items that can be eaten without utensils and from a napkin are welcome. Please no alcoholic beverages.
