REQUIREMENTS:

- Submit family friendly work suitable for a lobby in a public office building.
- All styles from traditional to abstract to conceptual are welcome and encouraged.
- Small-medium sculptures, fine jewelry and 3D works accepted. (Helpful if artist can supply pedestal, but not mandatory). There is limited tabletop and display cabinet space for the sculptures so they are accepted on a first registered, first served basis. Please contact us with any questions **WELL** in advance of delivery date.
- All works must be **WIRED** and ready for hanging. **No sawtooth or other type of hanging hardware will be accepted.** If you have any questions email us **WELL** in advance of delivery date.

Labels for the exhibition are prepared in advance, so your email submission must include ALL of the following for EACH PIECE. Please follow this EXACT format FOR EACH PIECE and submit in regular text in the body of your email (not as an image, not as a PDF, etc.) The info you provide is copied and pasted to create your label(s).

- Works must be delivered and retrieved on dates and times indicated. This is a public lobby space. **Artworks cannot be stored.** If you have any problems with the agreed upon times, contact GAL via email WELL in advance. If you cannot pick up your works as indicated, please make arrangements with a representative to do so. If a representative is dropping off your work, be certain that they have ALL the necessary information and are prepared to take the time to sign in for you properly.
- Only artworks will be accepted at the site. All protective wrappings and carrying devices must be removed by artist/representative and taken from premises.

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- All works must remain until the end date of the show. If you wish to remove a piece that has been sold, Goshen Art League must be notified, and the piece must be replaced with a work of the same size. A REPRESENTATIVE OF GAL MUST BE PRESENT AT ALL TIMES FOR THE REMOVAL OR INSTALLATION OF ANY ARTWORK FOR ANY REASON.
- Upon delivery of your work, you will be asked to indicate some sort of finger food you may like to contribute for the reception. Both savory and sweet items that can be eaten without utensils and from a napkin are welcome. GAL will supply beverages.

** VISIONS OF SUGAR PLUMS

The decorating theme and show title is, "Visions of Sugar Plums." As always, we invite you to be creative and think out of the box as well as traditionally. There's a lot of room for interpretation with this one. HAVE FUN!

You may find some inspiration from the Wikipedia entry:

"Sugar plums are widely associated with Christmas, through cultural phenomena such as the Sugar Plum Fairy in The Nutcracker (Tchaikovsky, 1892), as well as the line "Visions of sugar plums danced in their heads," from Clement C. Moore's poem "A Visit from St. Nicholas" (1823), AKA "Twas the Night Before Christmas."

In the children's board game Candy Land the character Plumpy, a gingerbread troll, wore a sugar plum around his neck. The Plumpy character was replaced in 2002 by Mama Gingertree.

Sugar plums have also gained widespread recognition via the poem "The Sugar Plum Tree" by Eugene Field. The poem begins "Have you ever heard of the Sugar-Plum Tree? 'Tis a marvel of great renown!"

"Sugar Plum" is also a 1971 jazz song by American jazz pianist Bill Evans, while Sugar Plum Fairies is a Norwegian folk and pop band formed in 2000."
