Reclaimed:

New Works On Vintage Surfaces

The Goshen Art League invites members to participate in the exhibit **Reclaimed: New Works On Vintage Surfaces**. No entry fees. Goshen Art League members only.

When the historic Goshen Music Hall was renovated, owner, Gerry Hluchan preserved the century-old roof tiles. League members are invited to create works on those tiles as a fundraiser for GAL. The tiles will be the focal feature of the first 2020 League exhibit at the Music Hall titled **RECLAIMED: New Works On Vintage Surfaces**.

Approximately three dozen slate roof tiles are available to GAL members on a **FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED** for this unique exhibit.

Artists are asked to agree to split the cost of the sale 50/50 as a GAL fundraiser. Proceeds will be used to upgrade our installation system at the Music Hall.

Artists have the option to submit **ONE (1)** additional piece created primarily from vintage or antique reclaimed items. If you did not receive a tile due to limited supply, you may submit **TWO (2)** pieces from vintage or antique reclaimed items.

RECLAIMED artworks - other than the tiles - may be priced by the artist. Artworks other than the works on slates will be on sale as usual and **NOT AUCTIONED OFF**.

Labels for the exhibition are prepared in advance, so your email submission must include **ALL** of the following for **EACH PIECE**. Please follow this **EXACT** format for

EACH PIECE and submit in regular text in the body of your email (*not as an image, not as a PDF, etc.*)

Tuesday, February 18, 9:30-10:30AM or 5:30-7:00 PM - NO early birds.
NO latecomers, please.
Installation of the show takes place immediately following.

Retrieve artwork:
Slate Auction- Thursday, March 26, 7:00-9:00 PM
All artwork that is not sold can be removed at 8PM after Auction - not earlier.
Additionally, artwork may be retrieved **Friday, March 27, 9:30 - 10:30 AM.**

REQUIREMENTS:

! Slate artwork may be designed horizontally or vertically. Artist need not devise an installation device for the slate. GAL installation team have devised a system for displaying the slate tiles. Artists have the option to sign and date their SLATE front or back at their discretion.

- Submit family friendly work suitable for a lobby in a public office building.
- All styles from traditional to abstract to conceptual are welcome and encouraged.
- Small-medium sculptures, fine jewelry and 3D works are acceptable **ONLY IF CREATED ON VINTAGE RECLAIMED MATERIAL.** There is limited tabletop, pedestal, and display cabinet space for 3D work, so they are accepted on a first registered, first served basis. Please contact us with any questions **WELL** in advance of delivery date.
- Goshen Art League will hang your slate tiles. No rigging or wiring of slates need be done by artist.
- GAL reserves the right to refuse any works that are unsafe, improperly framed or wired, still wet, or unsuitable for hanging in any other way.
- Works must be delivered and retrieved on dates and times indicated. This is a public lobby space. Works **MAY NOT** be left at the space without prior arrangement. Artworks cannot be stored. If you have any problems with the agreed upon times, contact GAL via email **WELL** in advance. If you cannot pick up your works as indicated, please make arrangements with a representative to do so. If a representative is dropping off your work, be certain that they have **ALL** the necessary information and are prepared to take the time to sign in for you properly.
- Only artworks will be accepted at the site. All protective wrappings and carrying devices must be removed by artist/ representative and taken from the premises.
- All works must remain until the end date of the show. **A REPRESENTATIVE OF GAL MUST BE PRESENT AT ALL TIMES FOR THE REMOVAL OR INSTALLATION OF ANY ARTWORK FOR ANY REASON.** All communications regarding anything to do with the exhibition should be addressed to Goshen Art League at: goshenartleague@gmail.com and **NOT** to any individual's private email, text, or FB messenger.
- Upon delivery of your work, you will be asked to indicate some sort of finger food or beverage you may like to contribute for the reception. Both savory and sweet items that can be eaten without utensils and from a napkin are welcome. Beverages will be provided by GAL.
